My gr. gr. grandfather Francis Marion Hatfield b. 1846 Howell Co., MO first found in 1850 census Greene Co., MO. FMH's father Elias Hatfield b. ABT 1806 TN, Mother, Nancy Smith Hatfield b. ca.1818 ILL My Francis Marion, had a cousin with the exact same name (Francis Marion (France) Hatfield b. 1848 TN, The cousin FMH lived most of his life in Howell Co. (perhaps Myatt TWP) and was likely among the first pioneer settlers. Cousin FMH is buried in Roskonancy Cemetery (spelling?). Cousin FMH visited my FMH in OK in 1921 and died while on the trip. Cousin FMH was colleted by his daughter Lillie Oney and taken back to Howell Co. for burial. I have a copy of his OK death certificate, it states that his father was William Hatfled and mother Mary Ellen Lancaster. I would like a copy of his Obituary if one was written in Howell Co. and a MO death certicate if one was created. Cousin FMH likely had a brother named Tilman, and father either William or Ale Hatfield I have not been able to ascertain the family connection between my Elias Hatfield and cousin Francis Marion's father.
