She had an older sister, Malena Emmaline who was born app. 1876. By 1885; their mother had died, their father took each to a different neighbor to be cared for; and he was never seen or heard from again. It is said he left in a horse drawn wagon. Ollie married Willard Davis Green in 1897 at West Plains, Mo. She had to have permissin to marry as she was only 17. Her guardianship paper are from a Mr. Cutter.....not the family who raised her. On her guardian papers; her father is listed as Gus Ures. No name or dates otherwise; and nothing for her mother. The family who raised her was a Mach Goldsmith or McGoldsmith. (the family seems to disagree which was correct) Malena married John Oliver on Feb. 18, 1899 in Howell co. He was said to have been married before; and had a son almost as old as Malena. (He name is listed as Lena Eurs on her marriage license.) I would really appricate any information for any connection to these 2 sister. Thank you!
